General Job Information

This position is partially funded through the Canada Summer Jobs program and requires that candidates are between 15-30 years of age and are returning to school in the fall or winter.

Job title: Summer student - Youth Programs and Farm Camp

Purpose of the position: The Farm Camp Assistant will be responsible for helping the Farm School Coordinator to run a summer farm camp and with other children's programs at Everdale farm

Start and end dates: We need students in May/June and in July/August.

Pay: \$12.50/hour; 30% off of all fresh food that Everdale sells. Home cooked lunches for \$3 per meal (or bring your own lunch).

Hours per week: 30

Work location: Everdale Farm, 5812 Sixth Line, Hillsburgh, Ontario.

Supervisor: Farm School Coordinator

General responsibilities of all Everdale employees

Specific roles and responsibilities of this position

- Work 30 hours per week. Work occasional weekends and holidays

- Coordinate, plan, prepare, and lead camp activities in a creative and age appropriate manor
- Communicate with Farm School/Camp Coordinator and camp staff about all aspects of camp programs (e.g. supplies, safety concerns, upcoming activities)
- Communicate and interact with parents about the camp programs in a professional manor



- Work with Farm Team as required during non-camp weeks under the supervision of Farm Manager
- Maintain a clean, safe, presentable, and professional working environment
- Maintain open and effective communication with Farm School Coordinator and other camp staff

Ideal skills, experience, and attributes

- An education background is valuable but not essential
- Knowledge of farming and agriculture is valuable but not essential
- Experience working with children is essential
- Current First Aid training
- Able to work outside in a wide range of weather conditions
- Able to consistently take a positive solution-based approach to challenges
- Self-motivated and enthusiastic
