General Job Information

Job title: **Farm Camp Assistant (summer job)**

Purpose of the position: The successful applicant will be trained to be a Camp Counsellor for Everdale's Farm Camp. They will be supervised by Everdale's Farm Camp Coordinator.

Start - end dates: July 8 – August 30, 2019

Rate of Pay: \$16.00 per hour; plus 4% vacation pay

Hours per week: 35 hours; Monday to Friday during the day

Work location: Everdale, 5812 Sixth Line, Hillsburgh, Ontario

Eligibility: Successful applicants must be: 30 years old or younger; and, hold a valid SIN number; and, be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or have refugee status. Students on a work permit or visa are not eligible.

Job expectations:

- Be punctual and ready to work selected hours.
- Be committed to working safely and efficiently.
- Follow lesson plans to lead students in farm activities.
- Demonstrate exemplary and age appropriate communication with students.
- Experience working with children.
- Basic knowledge of plant life cycles.



- Current First Aid training or commitment to obtaining certificate.
- Able to work outside in a wide range of weather conditions.
- Able to consistently take a positive solution-based approach to challenges.
- Work occasional weekends and holidays.
- Maintain an organized, safe, and beautiful site.
- Able to lift up to 40 lb regularly.
- Work with farm team as required under the supervision of Farm Staff.
- Able to perform physical, repetitive farming and gardening tasks.
- General farming tasks such as planting and weeding.
- Strive to carry out Everdale's mission and objectives and mandate.
- Develop and maintain effective working relationships with colleagues, the public, partner organization.
- Work with diverse groups and populations.
- Communicate openly and respectfully with others.
